Allocation of agenda items for the fifty-sixth session of the General Assembly

Addendum

1. At its 93rd plenary meeting, on 31 January 2002, the General Assembly decided to consider also directly in plenary meeting the following item, which had been allocated to the Third Committee:

68. Crime prevention and criminal justice (item 110).¹

2. At its 95th plenary meeting, on 11 March 2002, the General Assembly decided to consider also directly in plenary meeting the following item, which had been allocated to the Second Committee:

69. High-level international intergovernmental consideration of financing for development (item 107).²

3. At its 99th plenary meeting, on 22 May 2002, the General Assembly decided to consider also directly in plenary meeting the following sub-item, which had been allocated to the Second Committee:

70. Environment and sustainable development:

(a) Implementation of Agenda 21 and the Programme for the Further Implementation of Agenda 21 (item 98 (a)).³

5. At its 109th plenary meeting, on 23 July 2002, the General Assembly decided to consider also directly in plenary meeting the following item, which had been allocated to the Second Committee:

71. Implementation of the Habitat Agenda and outcome of the special session of the General Assembly on this topic (item 102).⁵

6. At the same meeting, the General Assembly decided to consider also directly in plenary meeting the following sub-item of agenda item 119, which had been allocated to the Third Committee;

72. Human rights questions:

(b) Human rights questions, including alternative approaches for improving the effective enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms (item 119 (b)).⁶
