Financing of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola

Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2001, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-sixth session the item entitled “Financing of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 59th and 60th meetings, on 23 May and 17 June 2002. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee’s consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/56/SR.59 and 60).
3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the report of the Secretary-General containing the final disposition of assets of the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola as at 20 June 2000 (A/56/900) and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/56/948).

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/56/L.80

4. At the 60th meeting, on 17 June 2002, the representative of Brazil, coordinator of informal consultations on this item, introduced, on behalf of the Chairman, a draft decision entitled “Financing of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola” (A/C.5/56/L.80).
5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/56/L.80 without a vote (see para. 6).

III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Financing of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission and the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola

The General Assembly

(a) Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General on the final disposition of assets of the United Nations Observer Mission in Angola¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;²

(b) Approves the donation of assets, with total inventory value of 235,800 United States dollars and corresponding residual value of 81,700 dollars, to various United Nations agencies and non-governmental organizations, as detailed in annex IV to the report of the Secretary-General.¹
