Appointment of a member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Mr. M. Riaz Hamidullah (Bangladesh) from membership in the United Nations Staff Pension Committee. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required, at its current session, to appoint a person to fill the remainder of the term of office of Mr. Hamidullah, which expires on 31 December 2004.
2. The Government of Bangladesh has nominated Mr. Md. Mustafizur Rahman to fill the vacancy.
3. The Chief Executive Officer of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund has been informed by the Chairman of the Asian Group that the candidature of Mr. Rahman has been endorsed by that Group.
