7. At the 22nd meeting, on 31 October, the representative of New Zealand, on behalf of Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Ecuador, Fiji, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Guatemala, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Japan, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Madagascar, Mali, Malta, Nauru, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, Romania, Samoa, Sierra Leone, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Ukraine and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, subsequently joined by Brazil, Iceland, Monaco, Papua New Guinea, Suriname and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, introduced a draft resolution entitled “Scope of legal protection under the Convention on the Safety of United Nations and Associated Personnel” (A/C.6/57/L.20).
