### Scale of assessments for the apportionment of the expenses of the United Nations

## Application of Article 19 of the Charter of the United Nations

### Report of the Secretary-General

1. In its resolution 56/243 of 24 December 2001, the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General to update the information contained in the annexes to his report on the application of Article 19 of the Charter of the United Nations (A/55/789).
2. That report had been prepared in response to General Assembly resolution 55/5 A of 26 October 2000, in which the Assembly, inter alia, requested the Secretary-General, in order to ensure the sound financing of the Organization, to review the implications of the calculation of assessed contributions in arrears for the purpose of the application of Article 19 of the Charter at the beginning of each calendar year and at the beginning of the financial peacekeeping period on 1 July of each year, and to report thereon to the General Assembly at the first part of its resumed fifty-fifth session, and decided, subject to the outcome of negotiations in the Assembly on the report of the Secretary-General and the recommendations of the Committee on Contributions thereon, at the main part of its fifty-sixth session and subject to further decision on its implementation by the Assembly, to compare arrears with the amount actually assessed and payable for the preceding two full years for the purpose of the application of Article 19 of the Charter.
3. As indicated in the report of the Secretary-General, the current procedures for the application of Article 19 involve a comparison at the beginning of each year of outstanding assessed contributions for each Member State with its total “gross” assessments (i.e., without adjustment for its share of estimated income from staff assessment) for the previous two years. For most Member States, gross assessments exceed the assessed amounts actually payable — what have become known as “net” assessments.

4. The outcome in 2000 of the current procedures for the application of Article 19 and, for illustrative purposes, the outcome with a biannual application of Article 19 and/or a comparison of outstanding assessed contributions of Member States with their total net assessments for the previous two years is summarized in annex I to the previous report. Those figures are updated in annex I to the present report by the application of the same parameters to the figures for assessments, payments and arrears in 2001.

5. In annex II.A to the previous report, gross and net assessments, payments and credits applied and amounts outstanding during the period from 1 January 1998 to 31 December 2000 are listed for Member States that fell or would have fallen under the provisions of Article 19 in 2000 under either the current procedures for its application or the alternatives reflected in annex I. Annex II.A to the present report presents the corresponding figures for the period from 1 January 1999 to 31 December 2001. Annex II.B to the previous report shows the calculation of the minimum amounts payable by the same Member States to avoid the application of Article 19 on 1 January, 1 July and 31 December 2000 under the current and alternative procedures reflected in annex I. Annex II.B to the present report updates this information by providing the corresponding figures for 2001. The annexes to the present report include information on Member States permitted to vote by specific decisions of the General Assembly under the provisions of Article 19. They do not reflect the arrears of the former Yugoslavia, which ceased to be a Member of the Organization upon the admission of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia on 1 November 2000.

6. As pointed out earlier, in analysing the results of this illustrative information, it should be recalled that the underlying pattern of contributions reflected in the tables occurred under the current procedures for the application of Article 19 and may have been affected by it. Had a system of semi-annual calculations been in place in 2001 or had calculations been made on a "net-to-net" basis, the pattern of payments, and hence the number of countries falling under Article 19, might very well have been different.

7. The report of the Secretary-General was duly considered by the Committee on Contributions at its sixty-first session. The conclusions and recommendations of the Committee are contained in its report.<sup>1</sup>
