Fifty-eighth session**Organization of the fifty-eighth regular session of the General Assembly, adoption of the agenda and allocation of items****Fifth report of the General Committee**

1. At its 6th meeting, on 8 September 2004, the General Committee had before it a report of the Secretary-General on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly (A/58/864), issued in accordance with paragraph 5 (d) of the annex to General Assembly resolution 58/316 of 1 July 2004.
2. The General Committee recommends that the General Assembly at its fifty-eighth session submit to the Assembly at its forthcoming session, in accordance with paragraph 2 (c) of the annex to resolution 58/316, section II of the report of the Secretary-General (Provisional agenda of the fifty-ninth regular session of the General Assembly organized under headings corresponding to the priorities of the Organization, as contained in the medium-term plan for the period 2002-2005).
3. The General Committee recommends that the General Assembly at its fifty-eighth session submit to the Assembly at its forthcoming session, in accordance with paragraph 5 (d) of the annex to resolution 58/316, annex I to the report of the Secretary-General (Draft programme of work of the plenary of the General Assembly at its fifty-ninth session), as orally revised on the proposal of the representative of the Netherlands that item 46 of the draft agenda (Integrated and coordinated implementation of and follow-up to the outcomes of the major United Nations conferences and summits in the economic, social and related fields) be considered in a joint debate with item 56 of the draft agenda (Follow-up to the outcome of the Millennium Summit).
