## I. Introduction

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2003, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-eighth session the item entitled “Report of the Economic and Social Council”.
2. At the same meeting, the General Assembly decided to allocate to the Third Committee the chapters of the report of the Economic and Social Council<sup>1</sup> that were to be considered under the relevant items of the agenda (see A/C.3/58/1).
3. The Third Committee considered the item at its 62nd meeting, on 1 December 2003. An account of the Committee’s discussion is contained in the summary record of the meeting (A/C.3/58/SR.62).
4. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the following documents:

## **II. Consideration of proposals**

### **A. Organization of work of the Third Committee and draft biennial programme of work of the Committee for 2004-2005**

5. At the 62nd meeting, on 1 December, the Secretary of the Committee introduced and orally revised the note by the Secretariat on the organization of work of the Third Committee and draft biennial programme of work of the Committee for 2004-2005 (A/C.3/58/L.80).

6. At the same meeting, statements were made by the representatives of Canada, Ethiopia, Italy and Malaysia (see A/C.3/58/SR.62).

7. Also at the same meeting, the Committee approved its organization of work and draft biennial programme of work for 2004-2005, as orally revised (see para. 11, draft decision I).

### **B. Report of the Economic and Social Council**

8. At the 62nd meeting, on 1 December, the representatives of El Salvador and New Zealand made statements (see A/C.3/58/SR.62).

9. At the same meeting, the Secretary of the Committee made a statement (see A/C.3/58/SR.62).

10. Also at the same meeting, on the proposal of the Chairman, the Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that it take note of the relevant chapters of the report of the Economic and Social Council (see para. 11, draft decision II).

### III. Recommendations of the Third Committee

11. The Third Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decisions:

#### **Draft decision I**

#### **Organization of the work of the Third Committee and biennial programme of work of the Committee for 2004-2005**

The General Assembly, pursuant to its resolutions 45/175 of 18 December 1990, 46/140 of 17 December 1991 and 50/227 of 24 May 1996, approves the organization of work of the Third Committee and the biennial programme of work of the Committee for 2004-2005, as contained in annexes I and II to the present decision.

#### **Annex I**

#### **Organization of work of the Third Committee**

##### **A. Guidelines concerning time limits of statements**

1. In accordance with rule 106 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly and paragraph 22 of Assembly decision 34/401, on the rationalization of the procedures and organization of the General Assembly, at the beginning of each session the Chairman of the Third Committee should propose to the Committee the limitation of the time to be allowed to speakers.

2. Further to General Assembly resolutions 45/175 of 18 December 1990 and 46/140 of 17 December 1991, on the rationalization of the work of the Third Committee, statements made by delegations and by Secretariat officials, unless decided otherwise by the Committee at the beginning of the session, should not exceed seven minutes. Statements made on behalf of a group of delegations or made in connection with the sub-items of the agenda item on human rights questions should not exceed 15 minutes. These time limits will be applied with a degree of flexibility towards all speakers. With a view to saving time, all speakers are encouraged to exercise self-discipline, in particular delegations associated with group statements. For practical reasons, group statements are encouraged for the first day of the discussion of an item or a sub-item. In this connection, it is important to emphasize the timely distribution of documentation in accordance with the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, in order to enable delegations to inscribe themselves on the list of speakers at an early stage.

##### **B. Draft resolutions on reports of treaty bodies and reports of the Secretary-General on the status of the treaties**

3. Reports of all treaty bodies will be submitted to the General Assembly in accordance with the respective legislative mandates of those bodies. Substantive resolutions on those reports should be adopted biennially, in accordance with the programme of work of the Third Committee. It is recommended that, where possible, draft resolutions on the status of the treaties not be submitted separately but be incorporated in the draft resolution relating to the report of the treaty body. In

alternate years, the Committee should simply take note of the reports unless more substantive action is deemed appropriate.

**C. Proposals emanating from subsidiary organs of the Economic and Social Council**

4. In transmitting proposals to the General Assembly, the Economic and Social Council should, to the extent possible, bear in mind the programme of work of the Third Committee.

**D. Programme of work**

5. An informal meeting of the Third Committee should be held immediately after the election of the members of its Bureau in order to consider the programme of work of the Committee on the basis of a draft to be prepared by the Secretariat and to consider other organizational aspects relating to the work of the Committee, especially the status of documentation.

6. The items allocated to the Third Committee for consideration during the fifty-ninth session of the General Assembly should be taken up in the following order:

- Item 9. Report of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, questions relating to refugees, returnees and displaced persons and humanitarian questions
- Item 10. Promotion and protection of the rights of children
- Item 11. Programme of activities of the International Decade of the World's Indigenous People
- Item 12. Elimination of racism and racial discrimination:<sup>1</sup>
