Organization of the fifty-ninth regular session of the General Assembly, adoption of the agenda and allocation of items

Fifth report of the General Committee

At its 7th meeting, on 29 November 2004, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Afghanistan, Costa Rica, Georgia, Kyrgyzstan and Nepal (A/59/238) for the inclusion in the agenda, under item 88, entitled “Groups of countries in special situations”, of an additional sub-item entitled:

“Rendering assistance to the poor mountain countries to overcome obstacles in socio-economic and ecological areas”.

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the sub-item:

- (a) Be included in the agenda as an additional sub-item under item 85, entitled “Sustainable development”, under heading B (Promotion of sustained economic growth and sustainable development in accordance with the resolutions of the General Assembly and recent United Nations conferences);
- (b) Be allocated to the Second Committee.
