1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2004, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-ninth session the item entitled

"Groups of countries in special situations:

- 7. Also at the same meeting, statements were made by the representatives of Qatar (on behalf of the States Members of the United Nations that are members of the Group of 77 and China), the Netherlands (on behalf of the States Members of the United Nations that are members of the European Union as well as Bulgaria, Romania, Turkey, Croatia, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Serbia and Montenegro and Iceland), China, Benin (on behalf of the Group of the Least Developed Countries), Norway, Bangladesh, Azerbaijan, Zambia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic (on behalf of the Group

- of Landlocked Developing Countries), Burkina Faso, Mali and Japan (see A/C.2/59/SR.29).
