Submission of a nomination by national groups

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. In a letter dated 4 November 2004, addressed to the States parties to the Statute of the International Court of Justice, the Secretary-General drew attention to the fact that a seat on the Court had become vacant as a result of the resignation, with effect from 11 February 2005, of Judge Gilbert Guillaume (France). In the same letter, the Secretary-General, in accordance with Article 14 of the Statute of the Court, issued the invitation provided for in Article 5, paragraph 1, of the Statute concerning the nomination of persons in a position to accept the duties of a member of the Court. He also requested them to submit any nominations by 17 January 2005 at the latest.
- 2. The Secretary-General has the honour to submit to the General Assembly and the Security Council, in accordance with Article 7 of the Statute of the Court, the name of the candidate nominated by the national groups (see annex).
- 3. The composition of the Court and the voting procedure to be followed by the General Assembly and the Security Council are set forth in a memorandum from the Secretary-General issued as document A/59/683-S/2005/51. The curriculum vitae of the candidate is contained in document A/59/684-S/2005/52.
