Financing of the activities arising from Security Council resolution 687 (1991): United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation Mission

Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2004, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-ninth session the item entitled "Financing of the activities arising from Security Council resolution 687 (1991): United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation Mission" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 47th, 48th and 56th meetings, on 2 and 3 May and 1 June 2005. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/59/SR.47, 48 and 56).

3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the following documents:

(a) Report of the Secretary-General on the final disposition of the assets of the United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation Mission (A/59/614);

(b) Related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/59/736/Add.14).

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/59/L.62

4. At its 56th meeting, on 1 June, the Committee had before it a draft decision entitled "Financing of the United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation Mission" (A/C.5/59/L.62), which was submitted by the Chairman on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Costa Rica.
