## Corrigendum

Paragraph 28 should read:

28. The action to be taken by the General Assembly in connection with the financing of UNMEE for the period from 1 July 2008 to 30 June 2009 is indicated in paragraph 43 of the proposed budget (A/62/811). The Advisory Committee recommends that the General Assembly approve the appropriation of an amount of \$100,367,400 for the maintenance of the Mission for the period from 1 July 2008 to 30 June 2009, subject to a decision of the Security Council. In view of the above, the Committee recommends assessment of an amount of \$50,183,700 for a six-month period, as follows: \$8,363,950 for the period from 1 to 31 July 2008 and \$41,819,750 for the period from 1 August to 31 December 2008, pending a decision on the future of UNMEE. The Committee further recommends that the Secretary-General be requested to submit a report to the General Assembly no later than 30 November 2008 on progress in the implementation of the budget, in order to provide for a revised appropriation and a further assessment, if required.
