35. With regard to the International Law Fellowship Programme, the Registry of the International Court of Justice provided office space and equipment for staff of the Codification Division and essential administrative and logistical support for the Programme. The International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia also provided financial and administrative support for the Programme. The Hague Academy of International Law provided a reduced tuition rate for Programme participants. The Carnegie Foundation provided a seminar room and equipment for staff of the Codification Division and lecturers. Regarding the Regional Course in International Law for Africa, ECA provided a seminar room, offices, equipment and administrative assistance, as well as transportation for lecturers, participants and Codification Division staff.
