

## Letter dated 19 September 2001 from the President of the General Assembly to the Chairman of the Second Committee

I wish to draw your attention to the recommendations on the organization of the session contained in section II of the report of the General Committee (A/56/250). Those recommendations were also approved by the General Assembly at its 3rd plenary meeting.

May I also draw your attention to the paragraphs of sections III and IV of the report concerning the agenda of the Main Committees.

I earnestly request your cooperation in these matters.

## Items allocated to the Second Committee

- 1. Macroeconomic policy questions (item 95):
  - (a) Trade and development;
  - (b) International financial system and development;
  - (c) Science and technology for development;
