Corrigendum

1. Summary

At the end of the summary, add the following paragraph:

References, citations and quotations are provided in the present memorandum with sole regard to the issue of the effects of armed conflicts on treaties and have no bearing on the characterization of an armed conflict; the subject matter of the dispute, including the issue of the status of disputed territories; or any other similar issue.

2. Footnote 314

Add the following to the footnote:

A dispute exists between the Governments of Argentina and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland concerning sovereignty over the Falklands (Malvinas). See ST/CS/SER.A/2 of 3 August 1999.

3. Section V.B

Add an asterisk to the heading “B. Selected armed conflicts after the Second World War”, and add the following asterisked footnote at the foot of the page:
