Implementation of the Lagos Plan of Action on New and Renewable Sources of Energy

The United Nations Conference on New and Renewable Sources of Energy meeting in Nairobi, Kenya, from 10 to 21 August 1981,

Referring to the Lagos Plan of Action, Chapter XI on Energy, reproduced in United Nations document No.A/S.11/14 of 21 August 1980, dealing particularly with the development of new and renewable sources of energy, which was adopted at the second extraordinary session of the Assembly of Heads of State and Government of the Organization of African Unity (OAU) in April 1980,

Noting the decisions contained in the Lagos Plan of Action, particularly the establishment of an African Energy Commission and an African Energy Development Fund for the implementation of the Plan in the field of new and renewable sources of energy,

Recognizing the need to strengthen existing efforts in the development of new and renewable sources of energy,

Calls on the United Nations organs and institutions and other international bodies to give full financial and technical support for the development of new and renewable sources of energy in Africa and further urges Governments and the international community to do the same. . NA/81-0318
