Promotion and protection of human rights and fundamental liberty in the combat against terrorism**

States have the obligation to protect human rights and the right to life of victims of terrorism and their families.

National antiterrorist strategies should create a healthy political environment using dialogue as a combat tool permitting potential victims to live a dignified life in the society.

Our organisations plead for adoption by the Human Rights Council of specific measures which would allow the High Commissioner of Human Rights to investigate good practices in the combat against terrorism in order to elaborate a manual of good practice.

Also that the Human Rights Council create a Voluntary Fund for the rehabilitation of victims of terrorism.

We ask states members to engage in a dialogue to adopt an international Day for 'Solidarity Against Terrorism' in remembrance of victims of terrorism around the world.
