2006/... Freedom of opinion and expression

The Human Rights Council, recalling Commission on Human Rights resolution 2005/38 of 15 April 2005, decides to request the Special Rapporteur on the promotion and protection of the right to freedom of opinion and expression, with the support of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights, to undertake a study on the issue of the security of journalists, in particular in situations of armed conflict, taking into account information provided by States and intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations, including national press associations.
