#### 1. Page 4

Paragraph 8 should read

In accordance with paragraph 47 of the annex to Human Rights Council resolution 5/1 and the requirements set out in Council decision 6/102, the consultative group composed of Luis Enrique Chávez Basagoitia (Peru), Omar Hilale (Morocco), Rytis Paulauskas (Lithuania), Yeonchul Yoo (Republic of Korea) and Elissa Golberg (Canada) will propose to the President of the Council a list of candidates for the new mandate holders for the following mandates, to be appointed by the Council at its twenty-fifth session: the Independent Expert on the effects of foreign debt and other related international financial obligations of States on the full enjoyment of human rights, particularly economic, social and cultural rights; the Special Rapporteur on extreme poverty and human rights; the Special Rapporteur on adequate housing as a component of the right to an adequate standard of living, and on the right to non-discrimination in this context; the Special Rapporteur on contemporary forms of slavery, including its causes and consequences; the Special Rapporteur on the right to food; the Special Rapporteur on the sale of children, child prostitution and child pornography; the Special Rapporteur on the rights of indigenous peoples; the Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Myanmar; the Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in the Palestinian territories occupied since 1967; the Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights defenders; the Independent Expert on the situation of human rights in Somalia; the Independent Expert on the enjoyment of all human rights by older persons; the Working Group on Arbitrary Detention (one member from the Group of African States and one from the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States); the Working Group on Enforced or Involuntary Disappearances (one member from the Group of African States); the Working Group on the use of mercenaries as a means of violating human rights and impeding the exercise of the right of peoples to self-determination (one member from the Group of

Asian States); and the Working Group on the issue of discrimination against women in law and in practice (one member from the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States).

After paragraph 104, insert a new paragraph reading

104 bis. In its resolution S-20/1, the Human Rights Council requested the Independent Expert on the situation of human rights in the Central African Republic to undertake an urgent visit to the Central African Republic, and to present an oral update on the situation to the Council at its twenty-fifth session. The Council will hear an oral update of the Independent Expert, Marie Thérèse Keita Bocoum.
