Corrigendum

1. Paragraph 21

The paragraph *should read*

21. In its resolution 25/1, the Human Rights Council requested OHCHR to monitor the human rights situation in Sri Lanka, to undertake a comprehensive investigation into alleged serious violations of human rights during the period covered by the Lessons Learnt and Reconciliation Commission, and to present a comprehensive report followed by a discussion on the implementation of that resolution at its twenty-eighth session. At its organizational meeting, held on 16 February 2015, the Council, pursuant to a recommendation of the High Commissioner, decided to postpone its consideration of the report of OHCHR until its thirtieth session. The Council will have before it a note by the Secretariat reflecting that decision (A/HRC/28/23).
