#### **1. Paragraph 40**

The paragraph *should read*

40. In its resolution 27/21, the Human Rights Council decided to organize a biennial panel discussion on the issue of unilateral coercive measures and human rights, starting at its twenty-ninth session. At its organizational meeting, held on 26 May 2015, the Council, pursuant to a request from the Permanent Representative of the Islamic Republic of Iran, in his capacity as Chair of the Non-Aligned Movement, decided to postpone the panel discussion until its thirtieth session.

*A global call for concrete action for the total elimination of racism, racial discrimination, xenophobia and related intolerance and the comprehensive implementation of and follow-up to the Durban Declaration and Programme of Action*

65 bis.
