The Human Rights Council,

Recalling Commission on Human Rights resolutions 2002/68 of 25 April 2002 and 2003/30 of 23 April 2003,

Recalling also Human Rights Council resolutions 1/5 of 30 June 2006, 11/12 of 18 June 2009 and 22/30 of 22 March 2013, in which the Council renewed and extended the mandate of the Intergovernmental Working Group on the Effective Implementation of the Durban Declaration and Programme of Action,

Encouraging the Working Group to enhance its efforts towards the effective realization of its mandate, and to report regularly in this regard to the Human Rights Council and the General Assembly,

- 1. Decides to renew the mandate of the Intergovernmental Working Group on the Effective Implementation of the Durban Declaration and Programme of Action for a further period of three years;
- 2. Requests the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights to make the report on the fourteenth session of the Working Group available in order to enable the Chair-Rapporteur to present it to the Human Rights Council at its thirty-fifth session;
