Note verbale dated 31 August 2017 from the Permanent Mission of Armenia to the United Nations Office at Geneva addressed to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Armenia to the United Nations Office and other international organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights, and has the honour to announce the publication of the ad hoc public report on fact-finding missions in Voskepar, Baghanis, Voskevan and Koti villages (Tavush Province, Republic of Armenia),* compiled by the Human Rights Defender of the Republic of Armenia, depicting gross violations of international human rights law and international humanitarian law by Azerbaijani armed forces from April to June 2017.
