38/... The human rights situation in the Syrian Arab Republic

Paragraph 27 should read

27. Further strongly condemns the terrorist acts and violence committed against civilians by the so-called Islamic State in Iraq and the Levant (Daesh), Al-Nusrah Front and other terrorist organizations designated by the Security Council, and their continued gross, systematic and widespread abuses of international human rights law and violations of international humanitarian law, reaffirms that terrorism, including the actions of the so-called Islamic State in Iraq and the Levant (Daesh), cannot and should not be associated with any religion, nationality or civilization, stresses the importance of the full implementation of Security Council resolution 2170 (2014) of 15 August 2014, and calls upon all States not to render any support to terrorists in the Syrian Arab Republic;
