Note verbale dated 14 February 2020 from the Permanent Mission of Armenia to the United Nations Office at Geneva addressed to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Armenia to the United Nations Office and other international organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights and, with reference to the note verbale of the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Azerbaijan (A/HRC/43/G/3), has the honour to draw the attention of the Office of the High Commissioner and the States Members of the United Nations, especially States members of the Non-Alignment Movement, to the fact that Azerbaijan misuses and abuses its chairmanship of the Non-Alignment Movement to make it serve its narrow national political agenda.
