Protection of Women Pregnancy and Quality of Human Life

The rights and civilization of women are crucial to a country's quality of life. Since its establishment in 2014, the Beijing Guangming Charity Foundation has been committed to protecting the rights and interests of children with autism and their families. Through research and practice, it has been found that this special group of children is seriously influenced by their mothers. When they were conceived as fetuses, the root causes of autism were planted in their parents, especially their mothers, due to environmental, climatic, food, water, emotional, and external factors and so on. If not discovered in a timely manner and measures are not in place, the pain of autism will accompany them for a lifetime.

In the course of more than eight years of development, Guangming Charity Foundation has received the assistance and support of experts from the China Academy of Chinese Medical Sciences, learned the essence of the Chinese Yellow Emperor's Canon of Internal Medicine and the theory and techniques of western brain science, refined and summarized the achievements of more than 30 years of practice, and carried out rehabilitation intervention and empowerment training for autistic children, parents, caregivers, and special education teachers.

From this, we have formed the Chinese experience and called for the protection of women's rights during pregnancy through various aspects such as hygiene and health, physiological and psychological training, social and cultural environment, etc., fundamentally creating a social and family foundation for women to become qualified mothers, and establishing a foundation for high-quality reproduction of human life.
