8/... Appointment of special procedures mandate-holders

The Human Rights Council, with regard to the appointment of thematic special procedures mandate-holders, decided that:

(*a*) All mandate-holders, on completion of their first term of three years, would require reappointment for the second term of three years by the Council;

(*b*) The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights would prepare and circulate a list of mandate-holders due for reappointment at least three months prior to the completion of their first term;

(c) Any Member State(s) may bring to the attention of the President objections that they may have regarding any special procedures mandate-holders, indicating the basis of their objections;

(*d*) Upon receipt of any objections, the President shall hold consultations with the concerned Member State(s) and regional coordinators with the aim of reaching a consensus; consultations may be held with other stakeholders if deemed necessary;

(*e*) In the event that no agreement is reached, the Council shall make an appropriate decision;

(*f*) In all other cases of special procedures mandate-holders who have completed three years and about whom no objections have been expressed, the President may recommend renewal of their mandates for another three-year term to the Council for approval.
