The Human Rights Council Advisory Committee,

Recalling Human Rights Council resolution 24/33, in which the Council requested the Advisory Committee to prepare a study on the situation of human rights of persons living with albinism and to submit a report thereon to the Council at its twenty-eighth session,

Recalling also that at its twelfth session the Advisory Committee established a drafting group, and designated Mr. Al Faihani, Ms. Boisson de Chazournes (Rapporteur), Mr. Coriolano, Mr. Hüseyinov, Mr. Obata and Mr. Okafor (Chairperson) as members of the drafting group,

1. *Takes note* of the draft report on the situation of human rights of persons living with albinism submitted by the drafting group to the Advisory Committee at its current session;¹

2. *Requests* the drafting group to finalise its report to the Council in the light of the discussion held by the Advisory Committee at its current session, as well as taking into account the outcome of the expert meeting to be organized by the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner in collaboration with the Organisation internationale de la
