#### **2/... Drafting group on gender mainstreaming**

*Recalling* Human Rights Council resolution 6/30 of 14 December 2007 on integrating the human rights of women throughout the United Nations system, in which the Council requested the Advisory Committee regularly and systematically to integrate a gender perspective into the implementation of its mandate, including when examining the intersection of multiple forms of discrimination against women, and to include in its reports information on and qualitative analysis of human rights of women and girls,

*Recalling also* that, at its first session, the Advisory Committee adopted a recommendation on integrating the human rights of women throughout the United Nations system, in which it requested Mr. Burney, Ms. Quisumbing, Mr. Sakamoto and Ms. Zulficar to prepare for the next

session a set of draft guidelines on methods to operationalize gender mainstreaming, including action-oriented mechanisms that would facilitate the implementation of the Committee's mandates,

*Taking note* of the draft guidelines on methods to operationalize gender mainstreaming, including action-oriented mechanisms (A/HRC/AC/2/CRP.4/Rev.2),

*Acknowledging* the importance of building on the existing work carried out by the various United Nations organs, agencies, mechanisms and treaty bodies and non-governmental organizations on gender mainstreaming and developing guidelines aiming at enhancing implementation and effectiveness of gender mainstreaming strategies,

*Recommends* that the Human Rights Council consider authorizing the Advisory Committee to prepare draft guidelines on methods to enhance implementation of gender mainstreaming, including action-oriented mechanisms within the Council and all other organs within the United Nations system, in consultation with all other relevant United Nations organs, specialized agencies, treaty bodies, national human rights institutions and non-governmental organizations.
