5/... Drafting group on enhancement of international cooperation in the field of human rights

The Human Rights Council Advisory Committee,

Welcoming Human Rights Council resolution 13/23, entitled “Enhancement of international cooperation in the field of human rights”, in which the Council requested the Advisory Committee to explore ways and means to enhance cooperation in the field of human rights, taking into account the views contained in the report of the High Commissioner on the enhancement of international cooperation in the field of human rights (A/HRC/13/19) and further views from States and relevant stakeholders, and to submit proposals in this regard to the Council at its nineteenth session,

1. *Entrusts* a drafting group with the task of undertaking preparatory work for consideration by the Advisory Committee;
2. *Designates* the following members of the Advisory Committee as members of the drafting group: Shiqiu Chen, Emmanuel Decaux, Latif Hüseyinov, Vladimir Kartashkin, Purificacion V. Quisumbing, Dheerujlall Seetulsingh and Halima Embarek Warzazi;
3. *Notes* that the drafting group elected Mr. Seetulsingh as Chairperson and Mr. Decaux as Rapporteur of the drafting group;
4. *Notes also* that the drafting group and the full Committee held meetings to discuss the matter under consideration;
5. *Encourages* the drafting group to continue its preparatory work, based on the outline presented orally, with a view to submitting further elements to the Advisory Committee at its sixth session.
