

Human Rights Council Eighteenth special session 2 December 2011

Letter dated 30 November 2011 from the Permanent Representative of the European Union to the United Nations Office in Geneva and the Permanent Representative of Poland to the United Nations Office in Geneva addressed to the President of the Human Rights Council

We have the honour to address the present letter to you to request the convening of a special session of the Human Rights Council entitled "The human rights situation in the Syrian Arab Republic", as provided for by General Assembly resolution 60/251, to be held on 2 December 2011, with a view to examining the situation of human rights in the Syrian Arab Republic in the light of the report of the commission of inquiry (A/HRC/S-17/2/Add.1) established by the Council in its resolution S-17/1 on 23 August 2011.
