Paragraph 84

For the existing text *substitute*

84. The United Nations country team stated that Serbia still hosted 203,140 internally displaced persons from Kosovo, of whom 71,779 remained with serious displacement-related needs, and that, as at 2014, there were 23,277 Roma, Ashkali and Balkan Egyptians officially registered in Serbia as internally displaced persons from Kosovo. It asserted that many of those persons led extremely marginal existences on the fringes of urban areas and that a lack of documentation confirming temporary or permanent residency made it difficult for them to find formal employment.
