Corrigendum

Correct Article X, paragraph 3 to read:

3. The Conference believes that lack of proper implementation of Article X prevents the less developed and developing States Parties from fulfilling their plans to control and eradicate infectious diseases. Therefore, the Conference calls upon States Parties to support an international system for combating and eradicating the emerging and reemerging diseases in humans, animals and plants and to support other specific programs, including collaborative vaccine R&D as well as relevant training programs, to improve the effectiveness of national, regional and international efforts on the diagnosis, surveillance, prevention, control and treatment of diseases caused by microbial and other biological agents and toxins, in particular infectious diseases. The Conference notes that establishment of a world-wide data bank can contribute to this end.
