## IMPLEMENTATION OF LEGISLATION AND MEASURES RELATED TO BIOSAFETY AND BIOSECURITY IN EU MEMBER STATES

Submitted by Germany on behalf of the European Union

- 1. At the Sixth BTWC Review Conference in 2006, the European Union presented Working Paper 3 (BWC/CONF.VI/WP.3) explaining the need and obligation of all States Parties to translate the BTWC in national law and regulations, including penal and other enforcement measures. UNSC resolution 1540 (2004) also obliges all States to implement national legislation and other measures to prohibit and prevent the proliferation of biological weapons. UNSC resolutions 1673 (2006) and 1810 (2008) reiterate this obligation. National legislation to implement biosafety and biosecurity measures contributes substantially to prevent and prohibit proliferation of dangerous biological materials.
- 2. The EU Member States have taken stock of their national laws, regulations and other measures in fulfilling the obligation to implement biosafety and biosecurity measures in national legislation. The results of the stocktaking are annexed in the form of a matrix for each EU Member State.
- 3. The matrix addresses
  - (i) Measures for safe/secure production, use and/or storage;
  - (ii) Measures for safe/secure transport;
  - (iii) Licensing/registration of facilities/persons handling biological materials;
  - (iv) Reliability/security check of personnel;

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- (v) Regulations for genetic engineering work;
- (vi) Control of importation and exports.
- 4. The matrix used is an adaptation of elements developed by the Committee established pursuant to UNSC Resolution 1540 (2004) with some minor modifications.
