PROVISIONAL AGENDA AND ANNOTATIONS

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The thirty-eighth session of the Committee against Torture will be held at the United Nations Office at Geneva (Palais Wilson) from 30 April-18 May 2007. The first meeting of the session will be convened on Monday, 30 April, at 10.30 a.m.

2. In accordance with rule 6 of the rules of procedure, the Secretary-General has prepared, in consultation with the Chairman of the Committee, the attached provisional agenda for the session. Annotations to the provisional agenda are also attached.

3. Pursuant to rule 31 of the rules of procedure, the meetings of the Committee will be held in public unless the Committee decides otherwise or it appears from the relevant provisions of the Convention that the meetings should be held in private.

In accordance with rule 66 of the rules of procedure, representatives of States parties are invited to attend the meetings of the Committee when their reports are examined.
