# **Status of submission of reports by States parties under article 18 of the Convention**

#### **Report of the Secretary-General**

1. Rule 49 of the rules of procedure of the Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women provides that, at each session, the Secretary-General shall notify the Committee of the non-submission of any report that States parties are required to submit under article 18 of the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women.

2. Annex I to the present report contains a list of the States parties whose reports are due and had not been submitted as at 15 May 2010. In some cases, the Committee has modified the date of submission calculated in accordance with article 18, paragraph 1, of the Convention, and this is reflected in the report.

3. Annex II to the present report contains a list of States parties whose reports were five years or more overdue as at 15 May 2010.
