Luxembourg stands ready to cooperate fully with all members of the Executive Committee with a view to finding constructive solutions to the various challenges with which the Office of the High Commissioner is confronted.

In light of the above, the Government of Luxembourg hopes that the Economic and Social Council will give favourable consideration to this request by Luxembourg and that it will recommend that the General Assembly increase the size of the membership of the Executive Committee.
