Addendum

- 1. The Programme Coordination Board of the Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS has 22 members. In accordance with its decision 1995/223, the Economic and Social Council, at its resumed organizational session for 2007, is to elect, from among States Members of the United Nations and observer States, eight members of the Programme Coordination Board for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2008 to fill the vacancies that will occur on 31 December 2007 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Brazil, Germany, India, Kenya, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Nepal, Russian Federation and the United States of America.
- 2. The eight members are to be elected according to the following pattern:

Two members from African States;

Two members from Asian States;

One member from Eastern European States;

One member from Latin American and Caribbean States;

Two members from Western European and other States.

3. The current membership of the Programme Coordination Board is given in the annex to the present note.
