# **Election of 19 members of the Governing Council of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme**

# Note by the Secretary-General

#### Addendum

- 1. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 56/206, the Council is to elect, at its resumed organizational session for 2007, 19 members of the Governing Council of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme for a four-year term beginning on 1 January 2008 to fill the vacancies that will occur on 31 December 2007 upon the expiration of the terms of the following members: Belarus, Bulgaria, Congo, Costa Rica, Germany, Greece, India, Israel, Jordan, Kenya, Mexico, Nigeria, Paraguay, Philippines, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Spain, Sri Lanka and Swaziland.
- 2. In accordance with paragraph 4 of section I.A of General Assembly resolution 56/206, the 19 members are to be elected on the following basis:

Five seats for African States;

Five seats for Asian States;

Two seats for Eastern European States;

Three seats for Latin American and Caribbean States;

Four seats for Western European and other States.
