First Alternative

WHEREAS the peoples of the United Nations are determined to promote social progress and better standards of life in larger freedom, and

WHEREAS the Members of the United Nations are pledged to co-operate in promoting and encouraging respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms for all

(Sixth paragraph replace "through" by "on the basis of" or "with").

Second Alternative

WHEREAS the Members of the United Nations are pledged to co-operate in promoting and encouraging respect for human rights and fundamental freedom: for all and are determined to promote social progress and better standards of life in larger freedom

(Replace "pledge" in sixth paragraph by "purposes") NOTE: Delete the fourth paragraph.
