RIGHTS OF THE CHILD

<u>Programme of action for the elimination of the exploitation of child labour</u>

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. By its resolution 1993/79, the Commission on Human Rights adopted the Programme of Action for the Elimination of the Exploitation of Child Labour. In the same resolution the Commission requested the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities to submit to the Commission every two years a progress report on the implementation of the Programme of Action by all States and decided to consider the question of the implementation of the Programme of Action every two years.
- 2. In its resolution 1997/22, the Sub-Commission requested the Secretary-General to invite all States to inform the Working Group on Contemporary Forms of Slavery of measures adopted to implement the Programme of Action and to report to the Sub-Commission at its fiftieth session and to the Commission at its fifty-fifth session.
- 3. Pursuant to that request, the attention of the Commission is drawn to the report of the Secretary-General to the Sub-Commission on the implementation of the Programme of Action (E/CN.4/Sub.2/1998/12), which will be available to the Commission at its present session.
