PROMOTION AND PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS

STATUS OF THE INTERNATIONAL COVENANTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Report of the Secretary-General

- 1. The General Assembly, in its resolution 2200 A (XXI) of 16 December 1966, adopted and opened for signature, ratification or accession the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.
- 2. Both Covenants and the Optional Protocol were opened for signature at New York on 19 December 1966. In accordance with their respective provisions, the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights entered into force on 3 January 1976, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights entered into force on 23 March 1976 and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, having received the required number of ratifications or accessions, entered into force simultaneously with that Covenant on 23 March 1976.
- 3. The General Assembly, in its resolution 44/128 of 15 December 1989, adopted and opened for signature, ratification and accession the Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, aiming at the abolition of the death penalty, and called upon all Governments in a position to do so to consider signing and ratifying or acceding to the Second Optional Protocol.

- 4. The Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights entered into force on 11 July 1991, three months after the date of deposit with the Secretary-General of the tenth instrument of ratification or accession.²
- 5. In its resolution 2000/67 of 26 April 2000, the Commission on Human Rights, inter alia, appealed strongly to all States that had not yet become parties to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights to do so, as well as to accede to the Optional Protocols to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and to make the declaration provided for in its article 41; invited the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights to intensify systematic efforts to encourage States to become parties to the Covenants and, through the programme of advisory services in the field of human rights, to assist such States at their request in ratifying them or acceding to them; encouraged States parties to consider limiting the extent of any reservations they lodge to the International Covenants on Human Rights, to formulate such reservations as precisely and narrowly as possible and to ensure that no reservation was incompatible with the object and purpose of the relevant treaty or otherwise contrary to international law. The Commission also stressed the importance of avoiding the erosion of human rights by derogation and underlined the necessity for strict observance by States parties of the agreed conditions and procedures for derogation under article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the need for States parties to provide the fullest possible information during states of emergency, so that the justification for the appropriateness of measures taken in those circumstances could be assessed. The Commission further urged States parties to fulfil in good time their reporting obligations under the International Covenants on Human Rights and in their reports to make use of gender-disaggregated data; it also urged them to take duly into account, in implementing the provisions of the Covenants, the observations made at the conclusion of the consideration of their reports by the Human Rights Committee and by the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights. The Commission requested the Secretary-General to ensure that the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights effectively assisted the Human Rights Committee and the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights in the implementation of their respective mandates, including by the provision of adequate Secretariat staff resources. It further requested the Secretary-General to submit to it at its fifty-seventh session a report on the status of the International Covenants and the Optional Protocols to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.³
- 6. As at 15 November 2000, the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights had been ratified or acceded to by 143 States; the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights by 148 States; the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights by 97 States; and the Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights by 44 States.
- 7. Upon ratification of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights or subsequently 47 States made the declaration provided for in article 41 of the Covenant, recognizing the competence of the Human Rights Committee established under article 28 of the Covenant to receive and consider communications to the effect that a State party claims that another State party is not fulfilling its obligations under the Covenant. The provisions of

article 41 entered into force on 28 March 1979 in accordance with paragraph 2 of that article. No inter-State communication under article 41 of the Covenant had been filed as of the date of the present report.

- 8. Under the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, individuals who claim that any of their rights enumerated in the Covenant have been violated and who have exhausted all available domestic remedies may submit a written communication to the Committee for consideration. As of the date of the present report, the Committee had registered over 950 communications and adopted final decisions on the merits ("Views" under article 5, paragraph 4, of the Optional Protocol) with respect to 354 of them.
- 9. Since the previous report to the Commission on Human Rights (E/CN.4/2000/89) the Human Rights Committee has adopted a general comment on equality of men and women (article 3 of the Covenant). At present the Human Rights Committee is considering a draft general comment on derogations and states of emergency (art. 4). The Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, at its twenty-second session (25 April-12 May 2000) adopted General Comment No. 14 on the right to the highest attainable standard of health (E/C.12/2000/4).
- 10. The lists of the States parties to the Covenants and the Optional Protocols, the dates of their ratifications, accessions or successions, as well as the dates of entry into force of those instruments for each State appear in annexes I and II to the present document.
