United Nations Decade for Human Rights Education, 1995-2004

Note by the Secretariat

1. In its resolution 2000/71, entitled “United Nations Decade for Human Rights Education”, the Commission on Human Rights, *inter alia*, recalled that, according to the Plan of Action for the Decade, during the year 2000 the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights, in cooperation with all other principal actors of the Decade, was to undertake a mid-term global evaluation of progress made towards the achievement of the objectives of the Decade and to report to the General Assembly on the results of the evaluation. The Commission urged Governments and intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations to contribute to the evaluation by providing appropriate information on steps taken, and requested the Secretary-General, through the High Commissioner for Human Rights, to submit to the Commission the recommendation of the mid-term global evaluation report.
2. Pursuant to that resolution, the Commission will have before it the report of the High Commissioner for Human Rights to the General Assembly on the mid-term global evaluation of the United Nations Decade for Human Rights Education (1995-2004) (A/55/360), which includes the above-mentioned recommendations.
