REPORT OF THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR HUMAN RIGHTS AND FOLLOW-UP TO THE WORLD CONFERENCE ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Note verbale dated 8 March 2005 from the Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Sudan to the United Nations and other International Organizations in Geneva addressed to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Sudan to the United Nations Office and other International Organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights and has the honour to enclose herewith two charts concerning the subversive and criminal activities by the rebellion movements in Darfur, Sudan, namely:

- 1. Armed robberies committed by the rebels before the N'Djamena ceasefire agreement on 8 April 2004 and after the signing of the agreement up to 30 November 2004;
- 2. Armed attacks by the rebels committed after signing the two Abuja Protocols on improvement of the humanitarian situation and enhancement of the security situation of 9 November 2004.

The documents mentioned above clearly show the intransigence of the rebel movements and their strategy of escalating violence with a view to inviting foreign intervention and undermining the peace process led by the African Union.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of the Sudan requests that the present note and its enclosures* be circulated as an official document of the Commission on Human Rights at its sixty-first session under agenda item 4.
