ARTICLE 5

(Right to Life)

List of items suggested by Governments for insertion in the enumeration of detailed limitations of the right safeguarded by Article 5:

- Suppression of rebellion or riots (South Africa)
 Deprivation of life by the military or state officers in a national emergency (U.S.A.)
- 2. Self-defence and defence of another (South Africa; U.S.A.)
- 3. Killing in attempting to effect arrests for certain offences (South Africa)
- 4. Killing by accident (U.S.A.)
- 5. Killing for violation of honour (U.S.A.)
- 6. Killing of persons caught in the commission of a felony (U.S.A.)
- 7. Killing to prevent an escape (U.S.A.)
- 8. Killing by medical operation in absence of gross negligence or malpractice (U.S.A.)
- 9. Killing through a voluntary medical experiment (U.S.A.)
- 10. Killing by officers of the law to prevent the commission of a crime (see also supra 6) (U.S.A.)
- 11. Killing by officers of the law in a local emergency (U.S.A.)
- 12. Killing by the military in time of war (U.S.A.)
