TERRORISM AND HUMAN RIGHTS

Letter dated 20 July 2000 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia to the United Nations Office at Geneva addressed to the Chairman of the Sub-Commission on the Promotion and Protection of Human Rights

I have the honour to transmit, enclosed herewith, a list of persons killed in terrorist actions by Albanian separatists in the Autonomous Province of Kosovo and Metohija in the period from 10 June 1999 to 30 June 2000.

In the period from 10 June 1999 to 30 June 2000, that is since the deployment of KFOR in the Autonomous Province of Kosovo and Metohija, Albanian terrorists killed 1,006 citizens (880 Serbs and Montenegrins, 77 Albanians - loyal citizens of the Republic of Serbia - and 49 persons of other nationalities).

Out of the total number of the killed citizens, 278 persons were not identified (246 Serbs and Montenegrins, 22 Albanians - loyal citizens of the Republic of Serbia - and 10 persons of other nationalities).

I would like to ask you to have this list* issued as an official document of the fifty-second session of the Sub-Commission on the Promotion and Protection of Human Rights under items 2 and 12 (b) (ii) of the provisional agenda.
