Replace the third sentence with the following text:

In order to enable a judge to determine whether a given State is fulfilling its human rights obligations towards individuals, much more precision is required when the violation of a social right is invoked (requiring a positive intervention from the State), than when the violation of a civil right is invoked (requiring essentially a negative obligation of non-interference).

For “social” *read* “civil”.
