REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL PURSUANT TO SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 1054 (1996)

## Addendum

- 1. Since the issuance of my report to the Council of 10 July 1996 (S/1996/541), a further eight replies have been received, bringing to 48 the total of replies received as at 17 July 1996 (2 of them from the same Member State). All the replies have been published as documents of the Security Council (see annex).
  - I. INFORMATION RECEIVED IN RESPECT OF PARAGRAPH 1 OF RESOLUTION 1054 (1996)
- 2. In a letter dated 10 July 1996 (S/1996/538), the Government of Ethiopia stated that the Sudanese authorities had not taken any steps to comply with resolutions 1044 (1996) and 1054 (1996).
  - II. INFORMATION RECEIVED IN RESPECT OF PARAGRAPH 3
    OF RESOLUTION 1054 (1996)
- 3. Seven of the replies received from Member States provided information regarding paragraph 3 of resolution 1054 (1996). Of those, one State reported that it had taken action in compliance with paragraph 3 (a). Another State indicated that it did not have diplomatic representation in the Sudan nor did the Sudan have diplomatic representation in it. Five other States reported that they had taken appropriate measures in compliance with paragraph 3 (b); two of these added that as they did not have diplomatic representation in the Sudan nor did the Sudan have diplomatic representation in their country, no action was required by them under paragraph 3 (a) of the resolution; two of the remaining three States indicated that they did not have diplomatic representation in the Sudan nor did the Sudan have diplomatic representation in their country.
