In fulfilment of its obligations pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 1373 (2001), the Government of Andorra submitted its most recent detailed report on 11 February 2005 in response to the request contained in the Committee's letter of 15 November 2004. On 6 April 2005, the Government of Andorra submitted an initial addendum in which it informed the Committee that on 21 February 2005 the General Council of Andorra approved the text of the new Andorran Penal Code, which entered into force on 23 September 2005.

In this second addendum, the Government of Andorra wishes to inform the Committee that the Principality of Andorra deposited its instrument of accession to the European Convention on Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters on 26 April 2005, and that the Convention entered into force for Andorra on 25 July 2005. Andorra thus became part of a vast network of multilateral cooperation that facilitates the exchange of information and documents in criminal matters among the States Parties to the Convention.
