COLOMBIA

In his cable of 29 January 1968,^{1/} the Permanent Representative of Colombia had occasion to reply, in conformity with instructions received from his Government, to the message addressed to him by the Secretary-General on 23 January 1968. The reply of the Government of Colombia concerning operative paragraph 3 of Security Council resolution 245 (1968) was included in that cable.

CONGO (DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF)

The Congo does not maintain any relations with South Africa through which it could exert any influence upon that country.

Our only action is the action we have undertaken and shall continue to undertake, together with other Members of the United Nations, to induce the South African Government, through the competent organs of the international Organization, to respect the world Organization's resolutions.

NIGER

The Government of Niger has shared the grave concern of the United Nations General Assembly at the trial of South West African nationals in South Africa. It would have wished to be able to endeavour to exert an effective influence on South Africa in conformity with General Assembly resolution 2324 (XXII) and Security Council resolution 245 (1968), but, since it maintains no direct or indirect relations with South Africa, it has been unable to take any steps in response to the invitation contained in operative paragraph 3 of the Council resolution.
